Visit to the Sharjah Energy from Waste plant

Members of the DWMC team visited the Sharjah Energy from Waste Plant, owned and constructed by Masdar and Bee'ah in a joint partnership initiative.

The plant which is located adjacent to the existing Bee'ah Recyling facility, has one boiler feeding one steam turbine, that will generate 30 megawatts of power for use within the emirate of Sharjah. DWMC team members had the opportunity to ask questions and undertook a site tour with members of the plant commissioning team. Recycling of waste to be used is carried out before delivery to the plant, and the DWMC team were interested to discuss some of the current initiatives being developed internationally for recycling waste and converting waste into fuels.



Further visits will be planned as the plant moves into full operations and Tim Clarke the DWMC CEO (Pictured second from left) was pleased to extend an offer to the Sharjah team to visit the DWMC facilities.
